# IVRCL bags orders valued Rs. 350.96 crores

Hyderabad: IVRCL is glad to announce that the Irrigation & Water Divisions of the Company have bagged orders of the value of Rs. 350.96 Crores lately.

## Irrigation Division – Rs. 324.67 Crores

The project aims to provide drinking water to 83 tanks of Magadi Taluk, Ramanagara District & Hutridurga Hobli, Kunigal Taluk, Tumkur District, from CH:192.3 km of Tumkur Branch Canal under Hemavathy Project.

The scope of work for the project includes design, supply, installation, testing and commissioning of Vertical Turbine pumping machineries and Rising main with surge analysis and suitable surge protection system, transformer, sub-station, construction of intake arrangements, transitions, sump, pump house, valves, electrical work, HOT crane, Raising main with MS pipe, delivery chamber, gravity distribution pipe network comprising of PSC pipes of suitable diameters including MS specials, valves, valve chambers for feeding design discharge to various impounding tanks including supply of spare parts, tools, main power for operation of the system & maintenance of the system for three years after the date of completion including conducting alignment survey, design and drawings for for Raising main and gravity main etc.

The work is awarded by Cauvery Neeravari Nigama Limited, Karnataka. The project is to be completed in 24 months.

## Water Division – Rs.26.29 Crores

The Project work is awarded by Karnataka Urban Water Supply & Drainage Board. The scope of work, primarily includes providing and laying of DI Rising & Feeder Mains, HDPE Distribution pipe line, Construction of 5LL and 4LL RCC OHT, Construction of Pure Water Pump house, Pumping machineries and 11KV express feeder lines for Remodeling of Water supply distribution system and allied works in Bannur town under UIDSSMT on item rate basis.

Subsequently, the project also involves construction and commissioning of 5 MLD capacity WTP with allied electrical & mechanical accessories, piping arrangements and trial run for 3 months on lump sum tender basis and finally Operation and Maintenance for a period of 5 years under Remodeling of Water supply distribution system to Bannur town at the contract price of Rs. 26.29 crores.
